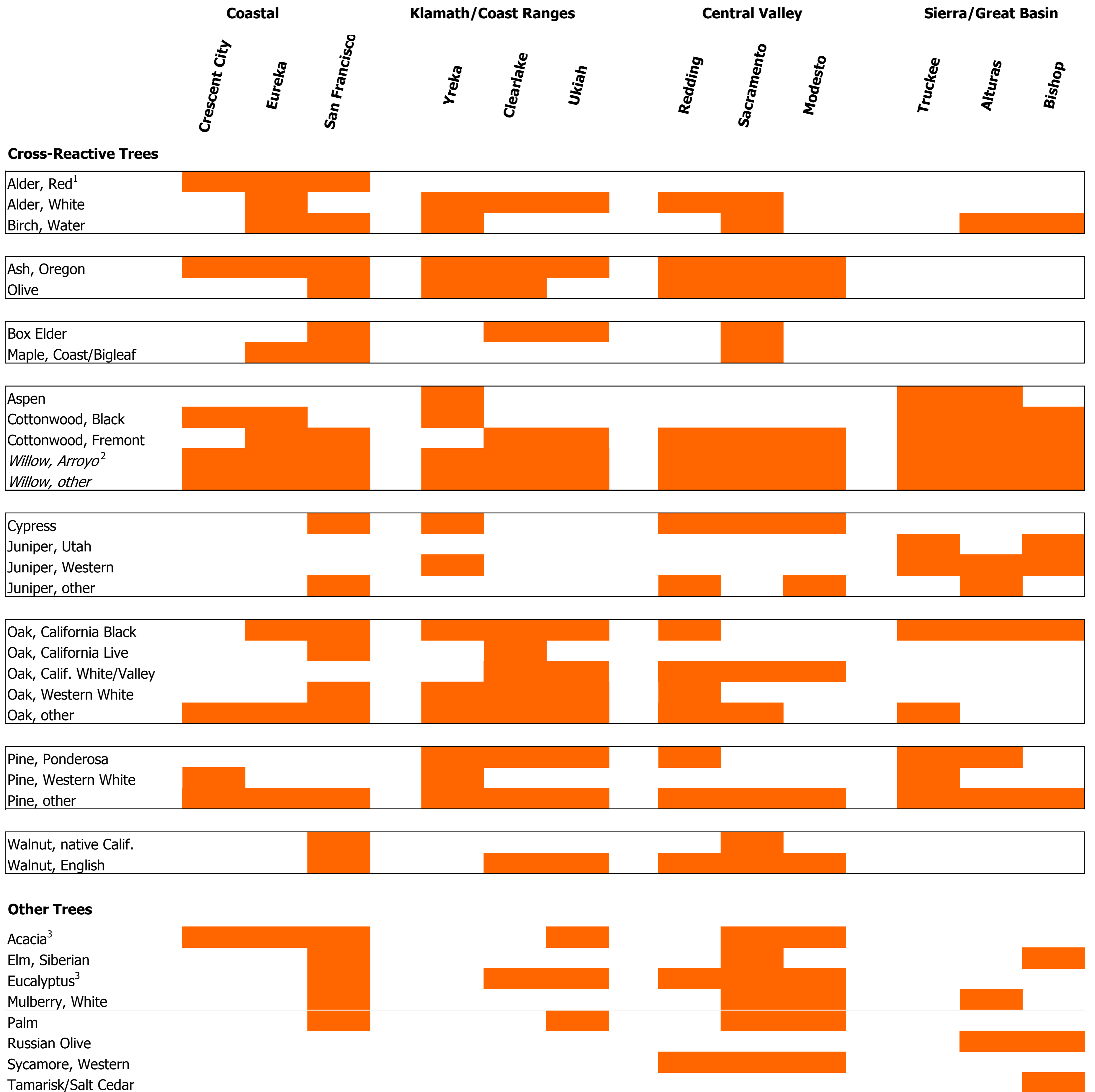


# Allergenic Trees of Northern California
